Hope everyone is feeling great and getting plenty of rest! There are four days till the Big Level Ride/March 22. We are so very excited!!

Our local police officer friends will be patrolling the courses that day, helping us to safely navigate on and around MS-15 and Highway 26. We will be providing route profile stickers with navigational cues, so you can be able to know where the next turn is without taking your hands off your handlebars. You'll hopefully have the RWGPS course loaded onto your phone or bike computer giving you turn by turn directions live, and the roads have also already been **marked with white tape** by our GCBC friends and fellow cyclists, Geoff Stockenstrom and GCBC Vice President, Mary Beth Lobrano. Huge shout out to Geoff and Mary Beth for taking care of that for everyone!

For anyone who missed the club meeting this past Friday, the "Eddie & Angie Holmes Volunteer of the Year Award" is going to be \$1,000 cash. We will be releasing the official points system for this asap.



Speaking of volunteers, here are the remaining needs we have:

1- If anyone has a truck and is willing to meet us at the road time trial happening Wednesday night at Woolmarket at 5:30pm, we'd love for someone take the bike racks from the club trailer, which will be there that night, and then bring them up to Big Level Saturday morning for the start/finish area. All the volunteers will be meeting up there Saturday morning at 6:30am, and so whoever agrees to this will also need to be okay with meeting us up there at that time.

- 2- Another need we have is someone who owns a truck committing to being the SAG driver for the day (likely driving out and about the courses from 9am till 1pm or so, looking for anyone who needs help). You'll need to be familiar with the course maps, which we'll help you with. We'll be supplying you with plenty of first aid supplies, tube repair supplies, electrolyte tablets, a small cooler with ice and water bottles, and markings for your vehicle, so everyone on the course knows you're with us. A truck is needed in case someone, along with their bike, needs to be transported back to the start for any reason. Your phone number will also be given to all participants during check in, so they can contact you in the event of an emergency where they need to be picked up asap. Just know that whoever commits to the SAG duty for Big Level and other rides we have this year is going to receive some serious points towards the "Eddie & Angie Holmes Volunteer of the Year Award!"
- **3-** We need one more volunteer who will agree to show up at 6:30am Saturday morning and help with parking organization, as people start driving in. We have a neon vest and two flashlights ready for you.
- **4-** A non-rider will need to oversee taking the finalized participant list and crossing names off as they finish, so we can make sure everyone makes it in safely.

Check in and same-day registration for all participants, regardless of their distance, will be between 6:30am and 7:30am under the large pavilion. 
